CLARK CEMETERY

The Clark Cemetery is located on East Hill above Town Road #59 on the farm originally settled by Theophilus Clark in 1792. In 1801 the town voted to have their agent take a deed of one half acre of land for a burying ground and see to fencing it. In 1973 it was in fair condition; in 1993 in deplorable condition. A trailer is parked within ten feet of the south-east line and only half the stones found in 1973 could be located. The place obviously has missed the care that Raymond Clark gave it in his lifetime. Zoning laws now would prevent any building so close to town property.

CUTLER CEMETERY

The Cutler Cemetery is located just below the junction of State Aid Highways I and 3, the County and Center Roads, at the town line dividing Montpelier City and East Montpelier. This is a sizable, well kept cemetery with only a few unmarked graves. The selectmen finally completed their dickering for the land after the death of Nathaniel Cutler. Mrs. Lucy Cutler gave them the land without expense, as much as the town needed.
