DOTY CEMETERY

north side of Town Road #26. It is at the north end of what was once the center of the town and the place the first settlers thought would be the important center.

This was the first burial ground for the town of Montpelier. Two acres was deeded to the town in 1794 by Joseph Wing the proprietor of all of lot #40 in the First Division of the town. The brush was cut and according to early town records it was to be kept fenced and leased for grazing with small cattle—no hogs.

Long abandoned the tomb stones were put in the wall and at the time of the 1927 flood the wall was used to repair the culvert at the nearby brook.

In 1871 descendants of Capt. Barnabas Doty searched for and discovered his stone built into the wall. One of them Silas Ketchum took the stone to the New Hampshire Antiquarian Society in Hopkinton, N. H. It was discovered there in 1973 and offered to the town.

Others were buried here but since no records were kept no one knows who. Lack of present day cemetery space and interest in the old cemeteries of this town have seen this first burial ground used again and the return of Barnabas Doty's stone by his descendants have given it a link with the past. In 1911, Mr. Bancroft, author of the cemetery cards located in the East Montpelier Town Clerk's Office called it the Doty Cemetery, a name well suited.

Gould Cemetery

The Gould Cemetery was located in the Gould Hill section of the town near Town Road 36 on what was once the David Gould farm, now land in the Sparrow family. The stones are in a pile, broken and disarranged. Reportedly, they were thrown aside about fifty years ago. It was said there were two to three dozen graves. The cards indicate a number of stones not found in the 1970s.
