FOPLAP HILL CEMETERY

This cemetery lies about one half mile north of North Montpelier in the town of Calais. It is a few yards off the road so not visible from route #14. About seventy-five percent of the people buried here were residents of East Montpelier; which is the reason we have included them in this edition of the Cemeteries of East Montpelier. It is a private organization. Much of the work of reading the stones was done by Pauline Coburn.



TINKHAM CEMETEPY

Tinkham Cemetery is a few yards west of the Quaker Cemetery, under old maple trees. The first settlers of the town, Solomon Dodge and John Templeton are buried here as well as their father-in-law, James Taggart. In 1973 several stones were repaired, the brush cut and grass mowed. On a tour of cemeteries in 1973 the history group found the grass mowed and the cemetery in good condition.
